Finance Committee

PPP Loan/Grant Update - Tim is simply keeping track of relevant expenses, but acknowledged that "the goalposts can change." One of our new Board members, Rachel, is a CPA and she will be very helpful in her role as the new treasurer, in this regard.

SBA just came out and said less than a \$2,000,000 loan will be considered as acting in good faith if they stated concerns about economic uncertainty.

Minister's Annual Performance Bonus - it was proposed that the bonus be paid with the May 2020 payroll budget, and funded by the PPP proceeds, and noted that the \$5,000 bonus is really a \$5,850 expense due to the additional costs of associated retirement costs and payroll expenses. Elizabeth made the motion to approve the raise, and Julie seconded it. All approved unanimously.

The Board entered Executive session at 4:00 pm.
