



How to Make Your Pledge to UUPD

2021 Guidelines & Helpful Information

WHEN TO PLEDGE

First, make sure to join us via Zoom on March 21, 2021 at 10 am for **Celebration Sunday!**

Options for returning your pledge card:

- ❶ **“Dazzle Drive Through” Pledge Card Drop Off**
Clearly the most fun option! How about 100% participation?
March 21, 2021, 1-3 pm
UUPD Parking Lot - 419 San Juan Drive, Durango
- ❷ **Mail:** Mail your pledge card to the church office: 435 San Juan Drive, Durango, CO 81301. **Please do not mail before March 21.** Mail as soon as possible AFTER March 21.
- ❸ **Drop off at UUPD**
AFTER March 21, drop your pledge card in the locked mail slot at the base of the church office stairs.

WHY PLEDGE?

UUPD relies on tax-deductible donations of its members and friends to fund the great majority of its operating expenses.

Fellowship attendees are encouraged to make an annual pledge of 5-10% of income if feasible to do so. The enclosed Suggested Fair Share Contribution Guide will help with decision making. We fully recognize the wide variety of financial circumstances of our members and friends.

HOW TO SET UP AND PAY YOUR PLEDGE

UUPD's fiscal year runs July 1 through June 30. Your current pledge should be finished by June 30, 2021, and your new pledge payment will begin on July 1, 2021. You have two options for paying your pledged amount:

Pledge payments by check: Be sure to write “pledge” on the memo line of your check, to differentiate this payment from a Sunday collection donation.

Pay electronically online. Follow simple instructions at www.durangouu.org. Click on “Donate” at the top right, then “Online Giving.” It's easy, we promise!

- Only you can authorize your new pledge payment to begin on July 1, 2021. You can set up payment anytime; just be sure to mark the beginning payment date as starting July 1, 2021.
- When you sign up, mark “Pledge” (not “Sunday Collection”).
- If your contributions are monthly or quarterly, be sure to mark “Recurring.”
