UUFD Congregational Survey Overview 2023


The survey ran for three weeks in late August and early September. There were 102 respondents. 89% of respondents are Members, 9% Friends and the rest Staff. There are currently 142 Members and 56 Friends.

Individual responses will be kept completely confidential. Answers cannot be linked to participants.

Note: List responses are in order of frequency from highest to lowest.


Favorite things about UUFD:


- 1. The People, Relationships, Friendship/Community, Welcoming/Inclusion
- 2. Spiritual Exploration and Intellectual stimulation, Worship Services
- 3. Social Justice, Community Engagement
- 4. Faith Formation Programs, Affinity Groups, Multigenerational Relationships
- 5. The Music, Choir




Respondents were asked to finish this sentence, "It could become **contentious** if the new minister tried to **change...**" and 82 people responded to this question.

- 1. **Changing too much, too quickly**, and without first seeking to understand or communicate or manage change.
- 2. Joys & sorrows
- 3. The third most frequent response focused on **shared ministry** and lay leader roles. UUFD's tradition of strong **lay leadership**.
- 4. Respondents also cautioned against changing **values** (such as our mission, principles, or theological approach).
- 5. Respondents called out a caution that the congregation may **not be open** to change.







Asked, "Why should the future minister consider joining the next chapter of our journey?", 83 congregants answered, resulting in the top answer categories:


1. Committed community, comprised of dedicated, hard working individuals


- 2. **Potential for growth and healing,** an eagerness to grow, experience new horizons, and heal the congregational culture
- 3. Social justice orientation, with active involvement to contribute to the larger community
- 4. Interesting community, with fun, open, and welcoming people
- 5. **Durango/Four Corners**, as a location and community, has much to offer, including outdoor activities and natural beauty

Racial diversity is lacking with 94% identifying as White, 2% Latinx and 2% Multiracial.

Age representation is not equally balanced with only 4% of respondents under age 40, 12% 40-60 years old and 62% over 70 years.


Sexual Orientation has some diversity with 1% Asexual, 2% Gay, 4% Pansexual (sexually or romantically attracted to people regardless of their sex or gender), 6% Bisexual and 83% Heterosexual.





Annual household income varied, with 24% of respondents earning less than \$50,000 per year, compared to nearly double (44%) earning more than \$100,000 per year.

Current employment status: 70% of respondents are retired, 16% working full time and 9% working part time.
